INDEPENDENT STUDY MASTER AGREEMENT

SHORT TERM Grades 6-8

The independent study master agreement is for the **2022/2023** school year. **Short term independent study shall be used for a minimum of 5 school days up to a maximum of 10 days within a school year, and must be requested at least 2 weeks in advance.** Independent Study is a voluntary, optional educational alternative in which no pupil may be required to participate; a classroom option has been offered and is always available. Before signing a written agreement, and upon the request of the parent or guardian of a pupil, the LEA shall conduct a phone, video conference, or in-person pupil-parent-educator conference to reconsider the independent study's programs impact on the pupil's achievement and well-being. In the case of a suspended expulsion student, pursuant to Ed Code 48915 or 48917, an alternative of classroom instruction has been offered and is available at all times. All resources and services of this school are also available to the student. If a student has a current Individualized Education Program it must specifically provide for enrollment in Independent Study.
